1. Details concerning the Year-end Dividends

JAPEX employs the basic policy of long-term, stable distribution of dividends in considering the retained earnings for investment in new oil and gas reserves and the development of transportation systems, including pipelines, as well as respecting the return of profits to our shareholders.

Item 2: Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation

1. Reasons for the Amendment

All stocks of JAPEX have become subject to Book-Entry Transfer System for Stocks, etc. (Electronic Share Certificates System) with the enforcement of the Act for Partial Revision of the Act on Transfer of Corporate Bonds, etc. for Streamlining Settlement Concerning Stock Trading, etc." (Act No. 88 of 2004; hereinafter referred to as the "Act for Streamlining Settlement of Stocks, etc.") on January 5, 2009. Accordingly, JAPEX proposes to revise the existing Articles of Incorporation as follows:

- (1) It is deemed resolved that the provision in the existing Articles of Incorporation to the effect that share certificates of JAPEX are issued was abolished on the date on which said Act was enforced. Therefore, JAPEX proposes to delete that provision, as well as provisions concerning share certificates in respect of Part Holdings and words referring to the register of lost share certificates. (Article 8, Paragraph 2 of Article 9, Paragraph 3 of Article 11, and Article 12 of the existing Articles of Incorporation)
- (2) With the abolition of "Act on Custody and Transfer of Share Certificate, etc." (Act No. 30 of 1984"), JAPEX proposes to delete words referring to "beneficial shareholders" and "the register of beneficial shareholders". (Article 10, and Paragraph 3 of Article 11 of the existing Articles of Incorporation)
- (3) In line with the deletion of Article 8 of the existing Articles of Incorporation as described in (1) above, the numbers of relevant articles from Article 9 shall be appropriately adjusted.
